Dear Poynor Park Neighbor,

You are invited to meet with Township staff and other neighbors of Poynor Park at the Campton Community Center at 5N082 Old LaFox Road on Wednesday, July 16 at 7:30 PM.

The purpose of the meeting is to give park neighbors and other interested residents an opportunity to learn more about the current conditions at the park as well as future plans. You will have an opportunity to ask questions, express concerns, and make suggestions.

Topics to be discussed include:

- What is the current status of the park construction?
- When will the park open? What sort of "grand opening" should we plan?
- What open space and recreational values currently exist at the park?
- What are the boundaries of the park? How should they be marked?
- How can we prevent encroachment? Will additional fencing be required?
- How are we managing the prairie plantings and other areas of native plants?
- What problems exist or can be anticipated at the park and how can we minimize them?
- What improvements would be welcomed?
- How can neighbors participate in maintaining and improving the park?

As park neighbors, you are in a unique position to benefit from the park. You are also in a unique position to help Campton Township by being a steward of the land. If you notice any problems that arise at the park, please alert the Township so we can address them before they become more serious.
